

APPROXIMATE PROGRAM INCOME GUIDELINES FOR 2010

These guidelines are approximate and may vary based on family debt and house size needed. Actual income requirements will be determined for each applicant after the application has been submitted.

Number In Household	Minimum Monthly Income Required To Qualify
1	\$1800-\$2200
2	\$1800-\$2535
3	\$1800-\$2855
4	\$1800-\$3170
5	\$1900-\$3425
6	\$1900-\$3675
7	\$2000-\$3930
8	\$2000-\$4185

These criteria must be met to qualify for the Habitat for Humanity program:

- Meet income guidelines
- Have a specific need for housing
- Be able to pay a 20-year, interest-free mortgage
- Mortgage can be no more than 30% of monthly income
- Mortgage plus debt payments (credit cards, car loans, student loans etc.) can be no more than 40% of monthly income
- Be willing to do 350 “sweat equity” hours building Habitat homes and working on Habitat projects
- Be a good representative of the Habitat program, its sponsors and volunteers
